The Wild Bill Guarnere Memorial Fund team has raised over \$50,000 after three events and online donations and hopes to raise the final \$12,000 needed to complete the Wild Bill Guarnere Bronze statue being created by local sculptor Chad Fisher at this event. The Wild Bill Statue will stand 8 foot tall and weigh over 3200 pounds. Donations are needed to offset the cost of the materials needed for this monument.

Sgt. William "Wild Bill" Guarnere, famous for his actions as a member of the legendary 101st Airborne Division's Screaming Eagles in World War II passed away March 8th. He was the recipient of the Silver Star, Bronze Star and two Purple Hearts. Sgt. Guarnere's wrote a book Brothers in Battle, Best of Friends: Two WWII Paratroopers from the Original Band of Brothers Tell Their Story and was famously portrayed by actor Frank John Hughes in the 2001 Emmy Award Winning HBO miniseries Band of Brothers, produced by Steven Spielberg and Tom Hanks.

The Golf Outing will feature a brand new car from O'Reilly Buick GMC that can be won by achieving a "hole-in-one." Lunch and snacks are sponsored by Picas's Restaurant, Herr's Foods, Subway and Turkey Hill. There will also be a 50/50 and other competitions for prizes throughout the day.
